<b>Discussion of Disease State</b>		
The discussion related to the patient case.		
Content was concise yet covered in depth.		
<b>Discussion of Drug Therapy Options</b>

Demonstrates in depth knowledge about the drug therapy options. Specifically, able to do the following:		
Discuss the drug(s) of choice, mechanisms of action, dosage, route of administration and duration of therapy.		
Support therapy recommendations with pertinent literature.		
Discuss common and serious side effects for each medication including relative importance and frequency of reactions.		
Describe and outline monitoring parameters including therapeutic endpoints.		
Define potentially clinically significant drug-drug, drug-laboratory, or drug nutrient test interactions.		
Describe non-drug treatment modalities.		
<b>Individualized Drug Plan</b>		
Recommends a plan specific to the patient that is supported by the discussions on disease state and therapy options.		
Drug Plan is complete and accurate:		
Includes drug(s), dose(s), route(s), duration of therapy, and monitoring parameters.		
Includes patient education strategies.		
Includes plan for follow up to monitor outcomes and potential toxicities.		
If recommended plan was implemented, what was the patient's outcome?		
<b>Conclusions and Critique of Drug Therapy</b>		
Able to summarize the following:		
How closely the patient case fits the "classic" case. (what are differences and similarities?)		
Do you agree with the therapy used? If not, what would you do differently and why?		
What were the most important therapeutic principles learned?
